

Practicals :

For each of the five practicals, you will receive a series of questions, to be answered in groups of ~6.

- Each practical session will start with a brief intro (5-10 minutes) on zoom (<https://unil.zoom.us/j/96982631237>), after which you will be randomly allocated to groups and migrated to breakout rooms to work on the practical.
- TAs will visit your room, but if you need, you can request help at any time in the corresponding slack channel (don't forget to give your room number).
- When in breakout rooms, make sure you interact with others from your group to solve the practical and discuss your findings. A suggestion if your internet is good enough is to keep your camera and microphone turned on during these breakout sessions. You might also find it useful to use a google doc or something similar shared between the people from your group
- 20 to 15 minutes before the end of the practical, we'll bring you all back in the main room to go over the practical's solutions and answer your questions.
- You can ask questions about any practical at anytime in slack using the appropriate channel, TAs will try to answer as soon as possible, but if you know the answer, please feel free to post it!
